GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

DATES: Friday, April 1, 5:00pm-9:00pm and Saturday, April 2, 9:00am-4:00pm

LOCATION: Benson Hilley Walking Trail Park, 5143 Williamson-Zebulon Rd.,
Williamson, GA. (Pike County), 6 miles SW of Griffin on GA Highway 362.

BOOTH FEES: Arts, Crafts, Antiques, Collectibles, etc.:
\$50.00
Food Booths: \$75.00
Booths requiring electricity (limited): \$100.00
Maximum electrical load per pedestal is 20 amps.
ALL booth spaces are 10ft. x 10ft.

APPLICATION: All applications are subject to approval by the City of Williamson. Please state what will have in your booth. You will only be able to sell what you have listed on your application. **YOUR APPLICATION WILL BE APPROVED OR DENIED BASED ON THIS INFORMATION.** First-time vendors, please include pictures of merchandise with the application. **Food Vendors** using oil or water must furnish containers to properly dispose of cooking oil and/or dirty water.

SET UP/TAKE DOWN: **Set up will begin AFTER 1:00 p.m. on Friday, April 1.** No one will be allowed to set up before 1:00 **(Do not bring your set up and leave it prior to this date and time).** Upon arrival, volunteers will be available at the information booth to assist you. Anyone who disturbs the landscaping will be responsible for damages and may be denied participation in future festivals.

IMPORTANT! All canopy areas are not to exceed 10ft. x 10 ft. Be sure that stakes are not a trip hazard. All vendor vehicles must be moved from the display area by 4:30p.m.on Friday and 8:30 a.m. on Saturday. **DO NOT PARK ANY VEHICLE ON OR NEAR THE WALKING PATH. NO EXCEPTIONS!** Booths are to remain open until 4:00p.m.on Saturday. No vendor vehicles will be allowed in the display area until **after 4:00p.m.** on Saturday for dismantling booths.

Upon departure, your booth area must be clean and free of trash. There should be nothing left in your space area, including food debris and gem clips. There will be trash receptacles available for disposal of debris. If you do not clean your area thoroughly, it could prevent your from being admitted to future festivals. Again, any food vendor who cooks with oil must take their oil home with them. Anyone who leaves oil, or pours it on the ground or in the ditch WILL BE DENIED future participation in the Festival.

Security: Security will patrol the exhibit area during off hours. The City of Williamson will not be responsible in the event of loss or damage.
